Inspection, Auditing & Equipment Integrity • Conduct routine inspections of rig areas, accommodations, hygiene conditions, and safety-critical equipment. • Ensure emergency response, well control, and lifting equipment are maintained and certified. • Maintain updated registers and tracking sheets (lifting gear, corrective actions, SOS, incidents, audits, inspections). • Identify non-compliance issues and ensure timely corrective and preventive actions are implemented. Incident Investigation & Reporting • Participate in accident/incident investigations using methodologies such as TapRoot. • Analyze incident data to identify trends and recommend preventive measures. • Prepare reports, follow up corrective actions, and ensure lessons learned are communicated to all personnel.
