- Conduct visual inspection of the H2S equipment & BA system to ensure that this essential equipment is in working condition 24/7. Report any defects/issues to H2S Technician (if assigned) or to person responsible.
- Provide support as necessary to enhance safe helicopter take-off and landing on board the rig. if no other person is available as trained HLO onboard.
- Maintain files and prepare required electronic and written reports/risk statistics including weekly, monthly, annual and environment reports and other related reports so that management can plan accordingly.
- Perform other duties as assigned by OIM or HSE department to ensure that flow of work is continuous and adequate relief is provided.
